FREEZER SALE RULES

1. To be eligible for the Junior Livestock Freezer Sale, a youth exhibitor must have exhibited his/her market-animal project during the current fair year and have conformed to the General Rules of the Walker County Fair and the rules for each livestock division entered.
2. Non-placing Junior Livestock Show exhibitor entries may sell only one animal or animal pen through the Freezer Sale. No exhibitor will be eligible to sell an animal through the Freezer Sale if he/she sold any other project during the current year.
3. Exhibitors must declare to the Livestock Committee Chairman their desire to sell at the Freezer Sale on or before noon of the Thursday preceding the Freezer Sale.
4. The Freezer Sale will be held immediately following the Horticulture Sale on the last Saturday of the fair. The exact time will be announced and will depend upon the auction-site availability.
5. No animal sold in the Freezer Sale will be allowed to exceed the lowest price paid in the same animal division in the Junior Livestock Sale during the current fair year. (For example: if Junior Livestock Sale's lowest selling lamb is sold for \$1,000.00, then no lamb may sell in the Freezer Sale for more than \$1,000.00). A notice will be posted designating the highest price allowed for each animal division.
6. Buyers will be requested to make their checks payable to Walker County Fair Association immediately following the Freezer Sale. Secretaries will be available to accept payments and to furnish receipts to buyers. The Walker County Fair Association will deduct an 8% commission from each exhibitor's proceeds.
7. Pictures will not be taken of buyers and exhibitors in the Freezer Sale.

This Freezer Sale was created to offer every non-placing youth exhibitor the opportunity to sell one animal and to offer the buying public a quality animal for slaughter. However, it is not the intention of the Walker County Fair Association to deplete or diminish the Junior Livestock Sale as it is felt that the Junior Livestock Sale is an award of excellence.
