

***Walker County Fair Adult Foods Division Rules 2012**

ANYONE THAT HAS WON AS "BEST OF SHOW" IN THE BAKED GOODS OR CANNED GOODS DIVISION IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO ENTER THE SAME DIVISION THE NEXT YEAR.

1. The adult food division is open to Walker County residents, not presently a student in a private/public school. Professional home economists or those who earn wages through food preparation are invited to exhibit but may not be considered in competition.

2. Entry fee is \$5.00 per item. Only one item per category may be entered.
3. Entry forms and fees are due at the time entries are turned in – no pre-registration
4. A list of adult entrants will be left at the Admissions gate so that you may enter the Fairgrounds to attend the awards presentation, the last Saturday of the Fair, before the Youth Baked/Canned Auction (time will be announced at the time of entering products.) Canned Goods must be turned in Thursday before the opening day of the Fair in the Committeeman's Room 4:00-7:00 p.m. Judging results will be posted by 5:00 p.m. the following day.
5. Baked Goods must be turned in the last Friday morning of the Fair between 7:00-10:00 a.m. in the Main Building. Results will be posted by 5:00 p.m. that day.
6. A "Best of Show" Canned Goods and a "Best of Show" Baked Goods will be designated by judges. Prizes will be awarded to each. A presentation ceremony is held prior to the Youth B/CG Auction on the last Saturday of the Fair.
7. All baked goods become the property of the WCFA upon entry into each contest. No entries or containers will be returned.
8. Canned goods may be picked up in the Committeeman's Room at the time specified at time of entry. Remaining items will be discarded.
9. All entries must include the recipe, the product in a disposable container and covered with plastic wrap. The participant's name should not be written on the recipe. Canned good entries should have a label attached to the jar indicating the name of the product.
10. There is no refrigeration available. Any entry requiring refrigeration will be disqualified. No ice chests or coolers will be allowed.
11. All entries must be made from scratch (except for decorated cakes and miscellaneous products) and must be the work of the person entering the item.
12. The Baked Goods Division will be composed of seven major classes: Cakes, Decorated Cakes (cakes can be made from mix – icing, fondant or any other type of coating must be made from scratch), Breads (no bread machine products are eligible), Pies, Cookies, Candies, and Miscellaneous. An entry is defined as "a whole product" or in the case of cookies, candies or rolls there must be at least twelve pieces included in the entry. The Canned Goods Division will be composed of nine major classes: Pickles, Relishes, Jams, Jellies, Fruits, Vegetables, Juices, Salsa and Miscellaneous.
