

Walker County Fair Adult Foods Division Rules

ANYONE THAT HAS WON AS “BEST OF SHOW” IN THE BAKED GOODS OR CANNED GOODS DIVISION IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO ENTER THE SAME DIVISION THE NEXT YEAR.

1. The adult food division is open to Walker County residents, not presently a student in a private/public school. Professional home economists or those who earn wages through food preparation are invited to exhibit their products but may not be considered in competition.

2. Entry fee is \$5.00 per item. Only one item per category may be entered.
3. Entry forms and entry fees are due at the time entries are turned in – no pre-registration
4. A list of adult entrants will be left at the Admissions gate so that you may enter the Fairgrounds to attend the awards presentation, the last Saturday of the Fair, before the Youth Baked/Canned Auction (at approximately 12:30p.m.).
5. Canned Goods must be turned in Thursday before the opening day of the Fair in the Committeeman’s Room 4:00-7:00 p.m. Judging results will be posted by 6:00 p.m. the following day.
6. Baked Goods must be turned in the last Friday morning of the Fair between 7:00-10:00 a.m. in the Main Building. Judging results will be posted by 5:00 p.m. that day.
7. A “Best of Show” Canned Goods and a “Best of Show” Baked Goods will be designated by judges. Prizes will be awarded to each. A presentation ceremony is held prior to the Youth Baked/Canned Goods Auction on the last Saturday of the Fair.
8. All baked goods become the property of the WCFA upon entry into each contest. No entries or containers will be returned.
9. Canned goods may be picked up in the Committeeman’s Room at the time specified at time of entry. Remaining items will be discarded.
10. All entries must include the recipe taped to the bottom of the disposable container. Write the entrants name on the back of the recipe.
11. There is no refrigeration available. Any entry requiring refrigeration will be disqualified. No ice chests or coolers will be allowed.
12. All entries must be made from scratch (except for decorated cakes and miscellaneous products) and must be the work of the person entering the item.
13. All entries must be covered in an appropriate manner – clear plastic wrap is the easiest to work with.
