ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- *Resides in Walker County for at least two (2) years and/or;
- *Attends either Huntsville ISD or New Waverly ISD, private school or home-schooled in Walker County. Applicants who are attending other area schools who are eligible to attend because of a parent educator in that district may also be considered;
- *Member of good standing in Walker County 4-H or FFA organization;
- *Is academically eligible to show in the Walker County Fair;
- *Must have been an active participant in rabbit project for at least 2 years;
- *Minimum GPA of "C" (2.0 GPA on 4.00 systems or equivalent) required;
- *Financial need, demonstrated leadership, participation given throughout your rabbit project are all considering factors as well as the submitted documentation.
- *Have been accepted for admission to an accredited college, vocational school or other institution of higher learning.

SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTATION WITH YOUR APPLICATION. **INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**

- *Recent color photograph;
- *Completed application;
- *Current and official copy of your high-school transcript showing gpa/rank;
- *Copy of letter of acceptance from an accredited college, vocational school or other institution of higher learning;
- ***THREE (3)** letters of recommendation, of which at least **two letters** are to be from a high school faculty member. The third letter can be from an additional source (e.g., employer, pastor, 4-H or FFA supervisor, or other personal acquaintance –not your parent). These letters should be in a **sealed envelope** and **marked CONFIDENTIAL.**
- *A brief essay addressing how you feel working with your rabbit projects over the years has and will help to benefit you in the future. This should be no more than two pages, double-spaced and typed (*no handwritten essays please*).
