

## 2012 Junior Clothing Division Rules

**ALL ENTRANTS SHOULD HAVE SIGNED A LETTER OF INTENT ON OR BEFORE THE LAST FRIDAY IN OCTOBER, AND PARTICIPATED IN AT LEAST TWO CONTENT RELATED ACTIVITIES.**

1. Junior clothing division is open to Walker County youth who are members of FCCLA or 4-H Clothing Project and are in the 3<sup>rd</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
2. Students will enter according to age groups as follows: 8(third grade)-10, 11-13, and 14-19.
3. All entries must have been constructed within the last year.
4. Contestants for showmanship award may model only one entry before the judge.
5. Entry fee is \$5 per item or outfit entered and turned it to teacher/county agent by Friday, two weeks before the opening of the Fair. This includes construction and consumer buying entries.
6. Entries are due at Fabric Carousel, Wednesday, before the opening day of the Fair by 5:00 p.m. Entries must be on hangers and protected by a plastic bag. Attach name and address for identification.
7. Pattern envelope, guide sheet and fabric sample must be attached to garment at time of entry.
8. Consumer Buying Division will be judged according to the 4-H criteria. Entries are due at same time as constructed garments, with buying results attached, on a hanger and protected by a plastic bag. Name and address attached. These entries will be judged at same time.
9. Judgings are not open to the public. Showmanship judging will be at 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, the week of the Fair. The Style Show and Awards Ceremony will be immediately following this judging at approximately 3:00 p.m.
10. Awards: Showmanship Awards for modeling in each age group will receive 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> places. Workmanship Awards will be 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> places in each age group. Overall Grand Champion will be selected in both showmanship and workmanship. The individual with the highest total combined score for one garment in workmanship and showmanship will receive a special high point award.
11. All garments will stay on display at the Walker County Fairgrounds through the closing of the Fair.
12. Wearable art includes decorated shirts, tee shirts, sweat shirts, vests and other miscellaneous items. **THESE ITEMS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR SHOWMANSHIP AWARD, BUT MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE STYLE SHOW.**
